I mentioned last week and want to reiterate that everyone must complete the <u>mandatory Covid-19 training</u> by the end of June. If you have not completed the training, you will not be permitted inside our facilities. As I've mentioned before, we've gone to great lengths to rethink our operations to ensure the health and safety of our faculty, staff, students and residents. This training is an essential part of that effort.

We continued this week to come to grips with the tremendous pain and grief that we all feel confronting some of the insidious systemic racism that is so deeply ingrained in far too many of our institutions. We've heard from many of our black faculty, staff and students about how this has personally impacted them. We, at Ostrow, are 100 percent behind you.
