

Last week, we welcomed the newest members of the Trojan Dental Family with the DDS Class of 2026 joining us for Orientation Week. SIM LAB A RENOVATIONS

The renovation of Sim Lab A continues, and we've made some great progress over the course of the trimester break. So far, we've managed to redo the flooring across the entire space and to begin to build out the benches and install the X-ray machines. As a reminder, the renovations will include the replacement of all 150 benches with sleek, modern workspaces, offering more counterspace than ever before; the installation of all new computers, mobile units and manikin heads; and the addition of 5 x-ray machines. The project represents our largest construction project in nearly two decades. We cannot wait to see the newly renovated space once it's complete later this fall.
