## DHOP'S BACK

After a three-year hiatus, the **Dental Humanitarian Outreach Program** (DHOP) made its first international trip this past December, traveling to the Bahamas to provide comprehensive treatment, including radiographs, scaling and root planing, sealants, composite restorations, pulpotomies, root canals and extractions as well as prophylactic care, to 227 underserved patients. Under the leadership of faculty advisor and director **Nineli Zadourian**, the group included 32 dental students, five USC faculty members, one DHOP alumnus and one mobile dental clinic staffer.
