There will be another opportunity for Ostrow students and residents to get their flu shot here at the Norris Dental Science Center. Ostrow's **Office of Student**

Life and USC Student Health have teamed up to host a flu vaccine clinic in the East Lobby on Thursday, October 12 from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Students and residents must have proof of flu vaccine compliance uploaded to MySHR by November 3, 2023. Medical and religious exemptions can be requested via MySHR. Thank you to Student Life and Student Health for making these vaccinations so easily accessible to our students.

Recently, our colleagues at the USC Suzanne Dworak-Peck School of Social Work featured our collaboration with them at the Dr. Roseann Mulligan Special Patients Clinic, the Pediatric Dental Clinic at the Los Angeles General Medical Center and the USC Dental Clinic at the Union Rescue Mission. For those of you who don't know, the master of social work students have the opportunity to participate in a nine-month practicum placement, where they work elbow to elbow with our dental students. The MSW students get the opportunity to apply in real time all that they've learned in the classroom. Our dental students get a better understanding of social determinants of health risk factors, including mental health disorders, medical conditions and comorbidities and how that might impact a patient's inability to come to an appointment or follow-through on compliance. You can read all about the program, led by Margarita Artavia, who has a joint appointment with Ostrow; Daniel Jacobs and Roseann Mulligan.

Finally, you might have seen that the Good Neighbors Campaign has launched. This is an opportunity for our faculty and staff to give back to the communities we call home with either a one-time donation or a payroll deduction. Some of the Ostrow programs that receive this funding are the USC Dental Screening Initiative for Foster Children, the USC Neighborhood Mobile Dental Van Prevention Program and, on the physical therapy side, USC Fit Families.
