

You might have heard over the break that we lost an icon. **Dean Emeritus Harold Slavkin**, who led the school from 2000 to 2008, passed away at the age of 85. You can't overstate the profound impact that Hal had on the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. One of the world's leading authorities on craniofacial development and genetic birth defects, Dr. Slavkin created USC's Center for Craniofacial Molecular Biology in 1989 and served as its first director until 1995. His own passion for scientific inquiry was instrumental in sharpening Ostrow's laser focus on research. It is in part because of his leadership and forward-thinking that today the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC is the third highest-funded dental school by the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, one of the National Institutes of Health. At USC, he founded the first graduate program in craniofacial biology in the United States. We are forever in Dr. Slavkin's debt, and I wish peace of mind to his family members and loved ones.

As you know, we are transitioning from Blackboard to the Brightspace Learning Management System effective Summer 2024. Next week, staff from USC's Learning Management System Transition Team will hold a hybrid presentation here at the Norris Dental Science Center, showcasing the platform's features and preparing faculty to begin creating courses.
