Welcome back! I hope you all got the chance to relax, reset and spend some quality time with your loved ones during the trimester break. The Fall 2024 Trimester has arrived, and I can't wait to get started.

Last week, we were excited to welcome the DDS Class of 2028 to the Trojan

Dental Family. Throughout the week, the cohort of students participated in a number of trainings and orientation sessions meant to get them up to speed on life here at Ostrow. They were also supplied with their scrubs and equipment/materials for the first trimester — a rite of passage for all new dental students. I really enjoyed getting to meet the group during our orientation session. Here's a little more about our DDS Class of 2028:

- —The class of 144 is 53 percent female and 47 percent male.
- —They come to us from 61 undergraduate universities. Top feeder schools include UCLA, UC San Diego, UC Irvine, USC, UC Riverside and UC Santa Barbara.
- —The students are academically diverse, with 36 different majors represented. The most popular majors include biology, biochemistry, chemistry, health, psychology, sociology, history, psychobiology, biomedical science, public health and natural science.
- —Six members of the incoming class hold master's degrees, and all of them hold a bachelor's degree.
- —The group is also regionally diverse, coming to us from 20 other U.S. states as well as Washington D.C. In all, we received more than 2,600 applications from 46 states.

Please join me in welcoming these new students to our school. They will join the ASPID Class of 2026 on Sunday, September 15 at Bovard Auditorium for the White Coat Ceremony, where they will put on their white coats for the first time and take their solemn oaths as healthcare providers. I'd like to thank the Office of Admissions, the Office of Academic Affairs, the Office of Technology Services, and the Office of Student Life and Well-Being as well as all the others who participated in orientation for their hard work in setting this class up for success. It's no easy feat, but everyone came together and did their part, and we appreciate your efforts.

As the university moves away from Blackboard to Brightspace for our learning

management services needs, our **Office of Technology Services** has been hard at work helping to facilitate the transition for our community throughout the summer.
