The **USC Mobile Dental Clinic** recently concluded a stop in Lindsay, Calif., a small town in Tulare County with a primarily agriculture-based workforce.

During the multi-day stop — an event that represents a partnership between Ostrow and our community partners Healthy Start Family Resource Center and Migrant Education Region 24 — our students and faculty provided comprehensive treatment to 70 individuals, ranging in age from 3 to 20 years old. Treatments included prophy, scaling, comprehensive exams, X-rays, oral surgery procedures, pulpotomies and restorations. Many of the children — particularly the younger ones — were in need of urgent care, having never seen a dental professional before. I'd like to thank all who participated in this event, helping to bridge this critical gap to oral healthcare. Thank you to faculty members Sunny Fereshteh, Nineli Zadourian, Daniel Romo, Rebecca El-Khoury, Elizabeth Brummel and Justin Urbano as well as the students and staff who participated. These clinics are a lifeline to so many of our neighbors in the Golden State, and I'm so proud of the work Ostrow does out there in the community.

Next week, we will hold our annual Research Day, one of the only days on campus devoted exclusively to scientific investigation. The event will take place at the USC Galen Center on Wednesday, April 9.
