The clinic was initially treating nearly 100 patients annually; over the last decade, it's closer to 800! As a clinician-scientist myself focused on congenital conditions like cleft lip/cleft palate and craniosynostosis, you can imagine that this clinic holds a special place in my heart for the oral healthcare it provides to

underserved communities who often have nowhere else to go. In fact, I can still remember how impactful my time was in Special Patients Clinic when I was a student myself, and I hear the same all the time from our students today. We're incredibly proud of the work that our Special Patients Clinic students, faculty and staff do every single day. I'd especially like to thank both Nan and **Piedad Suarez** for their leadership over this clinic. Just in case you forgot, our <u>Special Patients Clinic</u> received a \$3.4-million Special Dental Clinic Grant by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority to renovate and expand the clinic to serve even more patients with special needs, so we begin the march to the clinic's 50th anniversary stronger than ever before!

Finally, the deadline for our graduates to complete their requirements has come and gone. This year's class did an incredible job on their INDBE and ADEX exams as well as their on-time graduation rates. We couldn't be prouder of these accomplishments, so thank you to the faculty and staff who helped bring this class across the finish line.
